






31						 The zebra longwing butterfly is common to see around SISP. It's one of the few butterflies that utilizes pollen (that collects on its proboscis) in addition to nectar, as an energy source. This high-protein food helps it produce eggs. Zebra longwings prefer understory and shady areas and have a leisurely, "laid-back" flight. They often hold their wings open upon perching, all making them good subjects for photographing. In 1996 the species was named as Florida's official state butterfly. It's long-lived for a butterfly: some individuals survive up to 6 months.
